Last Meeting Follow-up

- 1. Approve Meeting Minutes from September 2020 member meeting Motion by Colin Second: Matt, Carried.
- 2. Join Catamount Trail Association- Tabled per AO discussion.
- 3. Insurance Policies Trail Liability update Erik: Town wants additional insurance from us, Erik (through VMBA) had WW added as "insured". Also, we are trying to start a youth MTB program and we will need insurance...Erik following up with VMBA.

New Business

- AO State of Affairs- Erik: An agreement was signed between WW Selectmen and AO regarding their relationship and the select board picked AO to manage all town forest lands...and that seems to be the beginning of some of our more recent disagreements. Continued clarification discussion regarding relationship histories, and trail background. Erik & Matt suggest we write a letter to the select board suggesting that we define our roles with ATA as the Trails organization (development & maintenance) and AO is the lift and Lodge people. Felicity suggested each organization defines (list)their role...reach an agreement, and list it on the bulletin board outside AO.
- Connector Name Discussion: Erik wants to name the three sections, Norcross trail, Crofter's way, and Barbara's Rhoad. The State must

approve the names. This will also include the entire trail. A suggestion was made to have Jason Rasmusen(State Development) administer the naming. Stan will follow up with Jason R.

- Grants -Stan: Of the \$2300 Owen Campbell had in the stagnant SRDC/WIC account, he has agreed to allocate \$1000.00 to ATA for Bridge costs. I have asked the SRDC for support on finding funding for several items and they have put me in touch with a State development person to get some funding for bridge completion/TAM to work. No interest in supporting new projects at this time.
- Trailhead Plowing- Stan: I talked with Barbara Rhoad regarding Plowing and in the past, she has used Andy Briggs at \$25 per lot (Brownsville & Windsor). The State plows the Weathersfield Trailhead and the lot across from the access road.
- New Network Request in Springfield at Muckross State Park. Tom Stuessy via Ethan Phelps contacted Erik. Discussion.
- Other News, we got a \$3000 donation from Todd Alexander from Norwich...just because we're awesome.

 - 1. Weathersfield TF update- Stan: No news, is no news! I have a call into Jeff Pelton to gently push for answers.

On a separate WTF issue is the continuation of the ??Trail which I have already marked most of the way through the TF. It will integrate well with the separate multi-level system we are proposing there but is not dependent upon it. I need to go for a short walk with Brian Renfro (State Forester) to get his preliminary approval to use an existing logging road adjacent to the playing fields as part of the trail entrance (a few hundred yards max).

 Powderhorn-Aaron-Will came to flag his proposed route and then we will be invited to walk the route with him. No invoice yet. Secondly, Aaron is interested in perhaps creating a sub-committee that specifically works on the "DH flow" trails.

We all agreed to straighten out the AO issue first. Felicity suggested putting it into writing to present to AO. Suggestion to have Glenn Seward be a member. Motion to form DH FLOW COMMITTEE by Matt Second: Wendy, Carried.
